

The port is open to all towage service providers that comply with the PLA Code of Practice for Ship's Towage Operations on the Thames.



1.12. Mooring and unmooring

Vessel mooring and unmooring at DP World London Gateway Port will be performed by the terminal's shore based personnel and charges are agreed with the vessel operator.

From the 1^{st} June 2020, a penalty charge of £1,000 per instance will apply to vessels found to be using Dangerously Weighted Heaving Lines (DWHL). This charge is donated to charity.

1.13. Vessel detention

Vessels detained for any reason beyond DP World London Gateway Port's control will incur charges and this will be informed on a case by case basis.

1.14. Vessel solid waste reception

Unless exempted, all vessels calling at DP World London Gateway Port are required to pay a charge towards the cost of waste reception as follows:

4.1. Booking a vehicle

4.2. Driver ID cards

To comply with DFT rules and regulations, together with assisting haulage firms with the management of obtaining Driver ID cards, please note the below:-

Drivers MUST have the correct documentation to enter the Port, without this entry will be refused.

- o Temporary ID Card Driving Licence
- Permanent ID Card Two forms of ID are required. Driving Licence, plus Passport, birth certificate, EU ID Card or Tachograph Card

Drivers are required to have either a Temporary or Permanent Driver ID Card to enter the Port. Both Temporary and Permanent ID Cards can be requested at the Gate Service Office. The charge will be applied to the company that is linked to the Driver's VBS booking and will appear on the monthly invoice

In order for Haulage companies to have visibility on Driver ID charges being accumulated, an automated daily report is sent to registered hauliers via email

Drivers arriving at the Port requiring a driver ID card should leave extra time for entering the Port and follow the instructions given by our Security Personnel

All drivers arriving at the Port must have a valid VBS slot

In special circumstances, the appropriate charge incurred as made by the Authority concerned will be for the account of the shipping line or other party as appropriate.

6.11. Pre-slung goods / shippers own lifting gear

Before any such goods are handled, a current test certificate for the Shippers Own equipment must be produced.
