


World's Busiest International Passengers Airport World 3rd Busiest Hub for International Air Freight Connecting to over 260 Destinations Worldwide

Dubai's two airports have a combined cargo handling capacity of almost 2.65 MMT. Warehouse infrastructure includes 56 truck docks for import, export and seven docks dedicated to sea-air traffic

Al Maktoum International (DWC) airport features a dedicated customs bonded road link to Jebel Ali Port, enabling rapid transit of sea to air cargo
